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
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## BE01: BRUSSELS - BRUGES

*Surprisingly close by and remarkably beautiful, that's how to describe Brussels and the various regions of Flanders in a nutshell. Flanders and Brussels, the capital of Europe, offer holiday joy for everyone: lovely bike tours through fabulous landscapes, culinary joy in great restaurants, cultural highlights in historical buildings and museums and of course the experience of the ever pulsating city of Brussels.*



### Day 1: arrival in Brussels

Things happen in Brussels! Not just because it's the capital of 500 million Europeans but also because there is an exciting cultural, artistic and social scene. Brussels with its historical beauty, galleries, small streets and multicultural soul is one of the greenest cities of Europe. A must for every visitor is the great market square, the Atomium, the Parlamentarium, Manneken Pis and Art Nouveau buildings, the icons of the city. Brussels, full of hidden treasures.

### Day 2: Brussels – Mechelen (65 km)

On the first cycling day, we pass along Leuven. This city is not only known as university city with the oldest Belgian university but also as a beer city. A walk in Mechelen, city at the river Dijle, will show you all the most important historical buildings, which were erected in the time of the Burgunds. You certainly have to visit the St. Rombouts-Cathedral, the palaces of Margarete of York and Margarete of Austria. You can also visit Kazerne Dossin from WW II or the toys' museum.



### Day 3: Mechelen – Bornem/Puurs (32/38 km)

In the morning there is plenty of time to take a 15-minute train ride from Mechelen towards the centre of Antwerp: enjoy a stroll on the Meir, have a beer on one of the many plazas or admire the rich architecture and art of this metropolis. From Mechelen we cycle along the river Rupel and Schelde to Bornem or Puurs.

## Day 4: Bornem/Puurs – Ghent (65 km)

Ghent, also the historical centre of Flanders, offers a variety of places of interest and is overseen by lots of towers, for example the one of the St. Bavo Cathedral with its world famous painting of the Adoration of the Mystic Lamb of Jan Van Eyck. The historical heart of the city is well preserved and you can visit the old port. Nearby, you will find the 'Gravensteen', once the medieval Castle of the Counts of Ghent, today one of the most important places of interest.



## Day 5: Ghent – Bruges (50 km)

The historical centre of Bruges is part of the world famous Unesco world heritage site list. Anyone who visits Bruges will notice it straight away: this city has always taken care of its architectural and cultural treasures. Take your time and stroll along lovely parks, intimate little streets and ancient market squares. You can also do some shopping: the shopkeepers will love to explain to you everything there is to know about our Belgian chocolate or beer. Or simply enjoy 'French' fries on the beautiful market square.

## Day 6: Bruges – De Haan – Bruges (55 km)

Ride along the canals to the picturesque village of Lissewege and continue to the authentic coastal village of De Haan, enjoying a refreshing dive into the North Sea or relaxing on the beach. Or you can also enjoy a free day for shopping, a boat ride on the canals, sightseeing by carriage, visiting some museums, climbing the belfry or a 15 min. train ride to the majestic port of Ostend.

## Day 7: departure

Departure after breakfast or extra night in Bruges or Brussels.  
Back to Brussels by direct train (50 minutes, 2 trains per hour) or transfer (+/- 1h 15 min.).

### Arrival

- Every Saturday from 02 May up to and including 5 September 2026
- Every Sunday from 5 July up to and including 16 August 2026  
Except 18, 19, 25 and 26 July: due to the annual Tomorrowland dancefestival exceptionally replaced by arrival on Monday 20 and 27 July.

### How to get there

- Brussels Airport (Zaventem) or Brussels South Airport (Charleroi), from Charleroi a direct bus to the centre of Brussels.
- Train: to Brussels, the first hotel is at 150 m from Brussels Schuman Station.
- Highway to Brussels. A GOOD HINT: a good value parking (€ 7/day) next to Bruges Station or the parking at Hotel Velotel (free during the stay, otherwise € 6/day). After parking in Bruges back-track by direct train in 50 min. to Brussels. When you arrive at the end of the tour in Bruges, your car is directly available and there is no need to return to Brussels.

### Level & roads

- Easy and flat, available for all cyclists and their children.
- Quiet roads and mostly cycle tracks along the Flanders Cycle Route, 90% signposted.



## BE10-11: BRUGES AND FLANDERS FIELDS

*The West-Flanders region offers an ideal mix of nature and culture. It is one of those unique places where you can enjoy silence along canals and open landscapes, but culture is never far away. Along the tour, you discover the story of the first World War (Ieper and Diksmuide). The most interesting town of this tour is of course Bruges, the famous historic town with its wonderful cultural heritage and many canals which has earned the city the surname 'Venice of the North'.*



### Day 1: arrival in Roeselare

After arriving in Roeselare you can make an optional tour to the basilica of Dadizele and discover the landscape around the city. Or first visit Roeselare, with the National Cycling Museum, the brewery of Rodenbach, the old cemetery, the city park along the Mandel river, the Castle of Rumberke with various exhibitions and the city center known for its vibrating shopping streets.

### Day 2: Roeselare – Ieper (31 km)

Our first cycling tour will take us to Ieper, a beautiful medieval town with a stunning market place and the famous town-gate 'Menenpoort'. We will also pass the Tyne Cot cemetery, the largest graveyard for English soldiers of World War I. In Ieper, you can visit the 'In Flanders Fields Museum' (to be paid on the spot). Cycling around Ieper is a nice experience, especially passing through the charming hills. You can also walk around the city and follow the ramparts route.



### Day 3: Ieper – Diksmuide (45 or 60 km)

On this tour, we will pass another nice medieval town: Poperinge, popular for the hops cultivated in this area. The 'Talbot House' is a place of interest, it was the only place during WW I where British soldiers could rest and forget about the war for a while. Definitely worth a visit is the trappist abbey of Saint Sixtus where the Westvleteren beer is brewed, voted best beer in the world. We will cycle further along the banks of the IJzer to Diksmuide, where the IJzertoren, a well-known monument of the great War can be visited. You can also enjoy the beauty of the historic market place.

## Day 4: Diksmuide – Bruges (62 km)

It is almost unbelievable how much cultural heritage can be discovered in such a rural region. Indeed, the destination we are all excited about is of course Bruges, with its historic center and the stunning belfry.

## Day 5: Bruges – Knokke – Bruges (64 km)

On the fifth day, we will explore the area between Bruges and Knokke, the most mundane village of the Belgian coast. It will be another unforgettable trip, through the polder landscapes and the dunes. The main sight of this tour is the nature reserve 'Het Zwin' and the picturesque village of Damme. Or, when it is warm enough, you can go swimming in the sea!



## Day 6: Bruges – De Haan – Bruges (52 km)

This day will again be an exciting day as we will visit another nice place on the Belgian coast. De Haan is a village which has preserved the 'Belle Epoque' style (19<sup>th</sup> century).

## Day 7: Bruges – Roeselare (58 km)

Our last cycling tour will bring us back to Roeselare. This tour passes two nice castles: d'Aertrycke and Wijnendale. Both are really worth a stop! After arriving in Roeselare, it is possible to visit the National Cycling Museum (to be paid on the spot).

## Day 8: departure after breakfast

### Arrival

- Every Saturday from 25 April up to and including 12 September 2026 ; except 8 August: replaced by arrival on Sunday 9 August due to the annual folk festival in Dranouter.

### How to get there

- Brussels Airport (Zaventem) or Brussels South Airport (Charleroi), then train to Roeselare.
- Trains: direct train from Brussels to Roeselare or with change of trains in Bruges.
- Highway to Roeselare, along A17 Kortrijk-Bruges, exit Roeselare-Izegem.  
The hotel in Roeselare has a car park (limited number of spaces but generally available) or underground parking at € 5 per day. Alternatively you can park for free at walking distance.



The best way to discover this region is by bike. You will cycle from historic Bruges to Ostend, the Queen amongst the Belgian coastal towns! Enjoy the beautiful landscapes in the hinterland, and above all your stay in a good hotel in Ostend!*



### Day 1: arrival in Bruges

The historical centre of Bruges is part of the famous Unesco world heritage site list. Anyone who visits Bruges, will notice it straight away: this city has always taken care of its architectural and cultural treasures. Take your time and stroll along lovely parks, intimate little streets and ancient market squares. ### Day 2: Bruges - Ostend (40 km)

On the way to Ostend, you can discover the nice village of Lissewege, one of the best examples of the cosy villages in the hinterland of the coast. The silence and the indescribable atmosphere will certainly seduce you! After Lissewege, the famous seaside resort Blankenberge follows, where you can visit the 'Sealife Centre'. Of course, we will also pass De Haan, a village which has beautifully preserved the 'Belle Epoque' style (19<sup>th</sup> century). After an unforgettable tour, we arrive in Ostend, also known as the 'queen amongst the coastal towns'.

### Day 3: circular ride Gistel, Wijnendale and Torhout (62 km)

Today we will discover some other nice places in the coastal region. Not only the landscape, but certainly the two castles on this tour will also make this day unforgettable! The first one is d'Aertrycke, which was built in 1869. The other one is Wijnendale castle, which has a history of 8 centuries!



## Day 4: circular ride Nieuwpoort and Veurne (64 km)

Nieuwpoort is just like Ostend and Blankenberge one of the favourite seaside resorts in Belgium. This small town is situated along the river mouth of the 'Yser', a river that played an important strategic role during the First World War. Enjoy the harbour and the nature reserve 'Ysermonde'. You can also have a break on the wide and lovely beach. The cosiness of the town of Veurne is not easy to describe in words. Veurne is renowned for the procession of the penitents.



## Day 5: Ostend – Bruges (47 km)

This tour will be very interesting! We will pass by Jabbeke, where you can visit the Constant Permekemuseum (paintings and sculptures). In the observatory 'Beisbroek', you can learn everything about the mysteries of the outer space, or you can strengthen your knowledge about nature in the 'Nature Centre'.

## Day 6: Bruges – Knokke – Bruges (62 km)

The sixth day, we will explore the area between Bruges and Knokke, the most mundane village of the Belgian coast. It will again be an unforgettable trip, through the polder landscapes and the dunes. The main sight of this tour is the nature reserve 'Het Zwin' and the picturesque village Damme. Or, when it is warm enough, you can go swimming in the sea!



## BE22-26: ROMANTIC CYCLING AROUND BRUGES

*Bruges is a nice town with surprisingly peaceful surroundings, the perfect place for a cycle trip! The best examples to describe the beauty of the region are the North Sea Coast or the typical polder landscapes. But, of course, Bruges is much more than a cycle destination. This town is also known as the 'Venice of the North' and is in many people's opinion the most beautiful Belgian city. Enjoy the small medieval town centre with its narrow canals, its numerous chocolate stores, its musea... Bruges has it all!*



All cycling tours are very easy to follow. The road book offers 4 tours, along a signposted cycle network. This network can also be found on the maps. It does not matter in which order the different tours are made.

### Tour 1: castles around Torhout and Wijnendale (69 km)

This tour will bring us to some interesting castles. The first one is d'Aertrycke, which was built in 1869. The other one is Wijnendale castle, which has a history of 8 centuries!

### Tour 2: Damme and Knokke at the North Sea (59 km)

On this tour, you will see the most picturesque villages of Flanders. A very popular example is Damme, because of the beautiful historic town centre. Many people visit Damme for the gastronomy and for the many interesting sights.

### Tour 3: Lissewege and De Haan at the North Sea (52 km)

Lissewege is a charming polder village, with a little canal flowing through the centre. The tour goes further to De Haan, a village which beautifully preserved the 'Belle Epoque' style (19<sup>th</sup> century).

### Tour 4: the park, castle and nature around Bulskampveld (55 km)

On this tour, we will cycle along the canal Bruges – Ghent. A popular place of interest is the 'Van Male Abbey'. This abbey was once the main castle of the Count of Flanders.



### Day 1: arrival in Bruges

Sometimes, it really looks like time stood still for some centuries: you can admire old houses, narrow streets, beautiful medieval buildings, ... But there are also nice restaurants, modern boutiques and a delicious gastronomy. There are truly loads to do in Bruges. As a family holiday, we will focus on the kids' favourites, on what they really want to see. A boat trip on the 'Reien' is always a nice experience. These boat trips usually take a half an hour. Kids will have a wonderful time in the chocolate museum 'Choco-Story'! But they will certainly also like the historical centre of Bruges, with the famous Market Square and the Belfry with 366 steps that they can climb. Or how about Zeebrugge? In Zeebrugge, you can visit the old fish market or see the ships of the port of Zeebrugge.



### Day 2: Bruges - De Haan – Ostend (40 km)

On the way to Ostend, you can discover De Haan, a village which has beautifully preserved the 'Belle Epoque' style (19<sup>th</sup> century). After an unforgettable tour, we arrive in Ostend, also known as the 'queen of all coastal towns'. The stay in Ostend will be a paradise for the children! The hotel is situated close to the beach and there is a lot to discover: children's farm 'De Lange Schuur', the playground 'Airport Bowl', etc. . ### Day 3: circular ride to Oudenburg (30 km)

*Let your fantasy take you away and imagine what drifts by in your mind if you think about the Netherlands. That might be picturesque landscapes, green meadows, historical villages with typical countryside houses and the softly spinning sails of the windmills. And let us not forget that here we can find one of the best varieties of cheese worldwide, those wooden clogs from back in the days and fields full of tulips. Our beach, town and tulip tour brings together the very best of the Netherlands in one bicycle tour. By bike you have the opportunity of visiting all these marvellous places in an active way. You can take in the adventure like a breath of fresh air, in all tranquillity and at your own pace.*



### Day 1: arrival in Amersfoort

Amersfoort is a charming city where the history is still alive. Behind the city walls you can walk at ease in the small streets. It is the perfect place for those who like shopping.

### Day 2: Amersfoort – Amsterdam (63 or 68 km)

Today we bike along the Naarden-Vesting, one of the best preserved fortifications in Europe, to the capital city of the Netherlands. The tour passes by the IJsselmeer, the former “Zuiderzee”. After an exciting bike tour we arrive in Amsterdam, famous for the abundance of quiet waterways that run through the city (Unesco Heritage). Make sure to go for a canal tour. Amsterdam has a lot of museums and cultural highlights. For example, the Royal Museum or the Van Gogh museum. Plunge into the lively atmosphere of Amsterdam.



### Day 3: Amsterdam – Zandvoort/Noordwijkerhout (50 or 60 km)

This tour brings us to Haarlem with the famous picturesque small “hofjes”. These are the gardens that were kept by the rich inhabitants in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> century for the aged widows to work in so they would not die of hunger. Or you can visit the Frans Hals Museum, a former home for retired people, where you can find the renowned paintings of Frans Hals. The tour continues along the “Keukenhof”, a wonderful garden, especially during the tulip blooming season. When staying the night in Zandvoort, you pass the “Keukenhof” the 4<sup>th</sup> day. Relish in the dunes and beach area with appealing sights.



## Day 4: Zandvoort/Noordwijkerhout – The Hague/Delft (45/55 or 60 km)

During this tour there are a lot of highlights. The road takes us to Leiden before ending in The Hague, Leiden is known for its university. There are interesting museums, for example the Royal Museum of Ethnology or plan a visit to the Pieterschurk. Before we reach The Hague, we pass by Scheveningen which has a beautiful beach. You will be accommodated in The Hague. This is the governmental centre as well. But The Hague has more to offer, numerous museums and sights along the canals, the “Catshuis”, “Paleis Noordeinde” and other cultural highlights such as the Mauritshuis. Walk through the old city center and stroll along the scenery of the canals.



## Day 5: The Hague/Delft – Papendrecht (45/60 or 68 km)

This tour will take us to Delft, an important university city like Leiden. Delft is also one of the oldest cities in the Netherlands and that is clearly noticeable from the wide range of beautiful buildings, sights and hidden treasures that tell us more about the glory of the old yester years when the city was expanding and filled with merchants. Delft retains its historical character with the typical canals. Then we cycle to “Kinderdijk”, famous for the beautiful windmills. This is one of the most typical sights in the Netherlands!



## Day 6: Papendrecht – Utrecht (62 km)

We continue this fabulous tour across the Netherlands passing by Schoonhoven to Utrecht. Schoonhoven is a romantic, characteristic small town at the river the “Lek”. In the close surroundings, many farmers keep the cattle for the legendary Gouda cheese. You can also visit the gold, silver and watches museum. Along the beautiful landscapes of this region, we bike to Utrecht. The old city center is nicely decorated with many waterways, just like The Hague or Amsterdam. Admire the impressive churches or visit one of the many museums, such as the Royal Museum.



## Day 7: Utrecht – Amersfoort (45 km)

For a last time, we can delight in the scenery of the Netherlands with its wide panoramic views. When you did not have the time for a visit to Amersfoort on the first day, you can do that now.

## NE15-16: IJSSELMEER, DUTCH NOSTALGIA

*Cycling around the IJsselmeer is an extraordinary experience! The lake was formed in the 1930's, after the damming of the former Zuiderzee. Before the 20<sup>th</sup> century, there were many small but lively villages around the lake where thousands of families lived of fishing. This belongs entirely to the past now. Today, the lake is especially known for its indescribable calm and the beautiful nature. On the banks, you will discover charming villages and towns. Enjoy the views over the water, the green forests and the enchanting Dutch polder landscapes!*



### Day 1: arrival in Nunspeet/ Elspeet

Nunspeet and Elspeet are situated in the middle of the beautiful nature of the 'Veluwe'. Around these villages, old farms, green meadowland and wooded banks can be admired. That is why Nunspeet is called the 'pearl of the Veluwe'.

### Day 2: Nunspeet/ Elspeet - Amersfoort (60 km)

The first cycling day brings us from Nunspeet over Harderwijk to Amersfoort. A first stop you can make during this tour is in Harderwijk. Harderwijk was a Hanseatic city between the 13<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> century. Remnants of the once important city are the city walls, the town houses and buildings of the former university and monastery. Amersfoort is a town where history is still alive. Behind the old walls you can walk through the cosy streets where you can also go shopping.



### Day 3: Amersfoort – Amsterdam (65 km)

On the third day we cycle to Amsterdam, capital of the Netherlands. With its famously scenic canals, rich history and iconic cultural scene, Amsterdam is one of the world's most vibrant cities. A very interesting sight on the way to Amsterdam is the Naarden-Vesting, one of the best-preserved fortifications in Europe. The landscape is dominated by the ancient bog 'Eemland'. Another highlight during this tour is the beautiful medieval castle Muiderslot. You can visit the interesting exhibition in the castle as well as the lovely gardens.

## Day 4: Amsterdam– Enkhuizen (65 km)

On the way to Enkhuizen, you should really visit Edam, famous for its excellent cheese! From Edam you will cycle to Hoorn. Hoorn calls itself “the pearl of the IJsselmeer”. Hoorn was founded in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. After the establishment of a division of the United East-Indian Company (Verenigde Oostindische Compagnie, abbreviated VOC) in 1602 the town gained international importance. Another place to see is the ‘Broeker harbour’. Our destination for today, Enkhuizen, was a leading port in the ‘Golden Century’.



## Day 5: Enkhuizen – South-Frisia region (35 or 40 km)

We take at 8.30 in the morning the ferry to Stavoren (luggage and bicycle to be carried by yourself on the ferry). The cycling tour will guide us through the typical Frisian landscapes. Stavoren for example has become very popular as the Eleven Cities Tour passes through there.

## Day 6: South-Frisia region - Zwartsluis (50 or 62 km)

Before leaving Lemmer you should definitely visit the only pumping-engine driven by a steam engine. The engine can pump up to 6 million m<sup>3</sup> water per day. Along the way towards Zwartsluis, we will cycle through the national park ‘De Weerribben’, an ancient peat moor area. En route you can also make a stop in Blokzijl or in Vollenhove. These places are ideal to relax a bit and admire the beautiful town centre. In Zwartsluis, where our hotel is situated, you can visit the former fortress Swartsluys, nowadays the place to be for water sporters.

## Day 7: Zwartsluis – Nunspeet/ Elspeet (52 km)

The most noteworthy point of interest is Kampen, once a Hanseatic city. This city has not less than 500 monuments. A must see in the city are the city gates, the 14<sup>th</sup> century Sint-Nicolaas church and the gothic house. After having passed the small village Noordeinde with its reed covered houses, we are back in the ‘Veluwe’ landscape, and after another unforgettable cycling trip, we are back in Nunspeet or Elspeet.



## NE30-31: THE ELEVEN-CITIES TOUR BY BIKE

*The peace, the nature and the race amongst the races (The Eleven Cities Tour) have made Friesland extremely popular with iceskaters but certainly also with cyclists.*

*The Eleven Cities Tour owes its name to two men who decided to skate past eleven towns in the winter of 1808, a total distance of 230 kilometers. To prove they really did it, they received the signatures of the owners of pubs or hotels in every town they passed.*



### Day 1: arrival in Leeuwarden

Leeuwarden is the main city of Friesland. In this historic town you can admire the small canals and walk through the nice shopping malls. There are also wonderful buildings, like the late gothic ‚Waag‘, and some museums. Interesting museums are the Museum of Nature and the Prinsessehof.

### Day 2: Leeuwarden – Sneek/IJlst (45 km)

The first cycling day brings us to Sneek, a small town that was once surrounded by canals and walls. You can walk through the nice centre and visit the city hall and the Martini church.

### Day 3: Sneek/IJlst – South-Frisia region (50 km)

Today, we cycle to region of South-Frisia, situated near the IJssel lake. We will pass the nice town Sloten, with 700 inhabitants the smallest one along the Eleven-Cities tour. Enjoy the nice village Balk, the charming villages and the typical Frisian landscape with the well-known terps!

### Day 4: South-Frisia region – Bolsward (51 or 58 km)

Bolsward is also a very nice town with picturesque streets, but it is certainly not the only one on this cycling day. Stavoren, nowadays famous among watersporters and Workum are worth a visit! These were all trade cities, with beautiful houses from the era of the ‚Hanze‘ cities and nice churches as witnesses of this glorious past.

### Day 5: Bolsward – Harlingen/Franeker (30/45 km)

On the route to Harlingen, you will pass Makkum, which is known thanks to the pottery. Enjoy your stay in Harlingen, at the 'Waddensee'.

### Day 6: Harlingen/Franeker – Dokkum (48/63 or 60/75 km)

On the way to Dokkum from Harlingen, we will first pass Franeker. Franeker once had a well-known university. Dokkum is a quite remarkable town, as the streets haven't changed since 1650. This city has always taken care of its architectural treasures. That is why the city has restored its fortifications and its historic walls.

### Day 7: Dokkum - Leeuwarden (35 km)

On the last cycling day, we go back to the place where we started: Leeuwarden. Along the cycling route, the enchanting Frisian villages Rinsumageest and Burdaard can be visited.

If you opt for travel insurance, the insurance premium is immediately added to your advance invoice. Failure to pay the advance of €175 per person or the balance does not mean the contract is terminated, but may result in cancellation costs. The balance must be paid no later than 30 days before departure. Anyone registering other participants with their signature is liable for fulfilling the obligations of all those individuals. Each participant must be aware that they act at their own risk.

## 2. Travel cost

Published prices are per person and inclusive of VAT. They were calculated in good faith on November 1, 2025, according to the then-applicable exchange rates. The right to adjust prices due to changes in exchange rates is reserved. Depending on the cancellation date, charges are applied

- cancellation up to 8 weeks before departure: 10% of the travel cost
- cancellation up to 4 weeks before departure: 50% of the travel cost
- cancellation up to 1 day before departure: 80% of the travel cost
- cancellation < 1 day before departure: 100% of the travel cost

This risk can be covered by taking out cancellation insurance

## 5. Cancellation or modification of the contract by VOS Travel NV

VOS Travel reserves the right to cancel a trip in whole or in part if extraordinary circumstances occur before or during the trip, i.e., circumstances that VOS Travel could not have known when selling the trip and would have prevented it from taking place. The participant receives a full refund of the registration fee already paid. VOS Travel NV may make changes to the travel program or accommodation after the travel confirmation, but must immediately inform the participant of such changes.

## 6. Limited liability

Costs resulting from transport delays due to weather conditions, defects, strikes, war, schedule changes, are not the responsibility of VOS Travel. The travel organizer is not liable for unforeseen events, such as epidemics, wars, so any additional transportation and/or accommodation costs are the responsibility of the traveler. The traveler acknowledges being informed about current official travel advice from the government and being informed about the exceptional circumstances caused by a pandemic (e.g., Covid-19) that may affect the trip and the pandemic situation at the

travel destination. The traveler declares to be fully aware of the risks that the pandemic poses to the smooth running of his trip and decides to travel with full knowledge of the facts.

#### **7. Late payment**

If the amount due is not settled on its due date, a late payment interest of 5% per month will automatically apply from the invoice date, without the need for a registered reminder. Each started month will be counted as a full month.

#### **8. Travel documents**

The traveler must have the necessary documents upon departure and throughout the journey. All consequences of non-compliance with local instructions and related costs are at the traveler's expense. A set of travel documents per room will be available at the first hotel.

#### **9. Complaints procedure**

9.1 The content of brochures, websites, and roadbooks is compiled in good faith.

9.2 The traveler must inform VOS Travel promptly, in a substantiated manner, of any non-conformity experienced during the execution of the package travel agreement so that a solution can be immediately sought and VOS Travel can have the chance to remedy any shortcomings during the trip. Complaints will not be accepted after the trip without this notification during the trip.

9.3 The value of services not received will only be refunded upon submission of the services the traveler did not receive and can never exceed the original price.

#### **10. Travel Disputes Committee (Geschillencommissie Reizen)**

10.1 A "dispute" arises when a complaint cannot be resolved amicably or is not resolved within four months from the end of the travel contract or from the planned departure date if the travel contract was never executed.

10.2 Any dispute arising after the conclusion of a travel contract is exclusively handled by the Geschillencommissie Reizen vzw, with the exception of disputes over bodily injury.

10.3 The treatment and decision are made in accordance with the dispute regulations and the provisions of the judicial code on arbitration. The decision is binding on the parties, without the possibility of appeal. A fee is due for the handling of a dispute as determined in the Dispute Regulation.

10.4 The use of these general terms implies acceptance of all regulations and decisions determined by the Geschillencommissie Reizen vzw, especially the Dispute Regulation.

#### **11. Legal guarantee**

A legal guarantee of €35,000 covers our professional commitments under the conditions set by the Royal Decree of June 30, 1966, amended by the Decree of the Flemish Government of April 2, 1996 (B.S. May 21, 1996). This guarantee can only be used after sending a registered letter of payment reminder to the debtor and sending a copy to Tourism Flanders, Grasmarkt 61, 1000 Brussels. The reminder and the copy must be sent within twelve months after the completion of the work that caused the debt.

#### **12. Financial protection**

In accordance with Article 36 of the travel contracts law, VOS Travel NV is insured by Amlin Insurance SE, with registered office in London UK Companies House no. SEO 00095, to fulfill its obligations towards the traveler in case of financial inability.
